The leader is responsible to sign when the scout have done the different tasks.

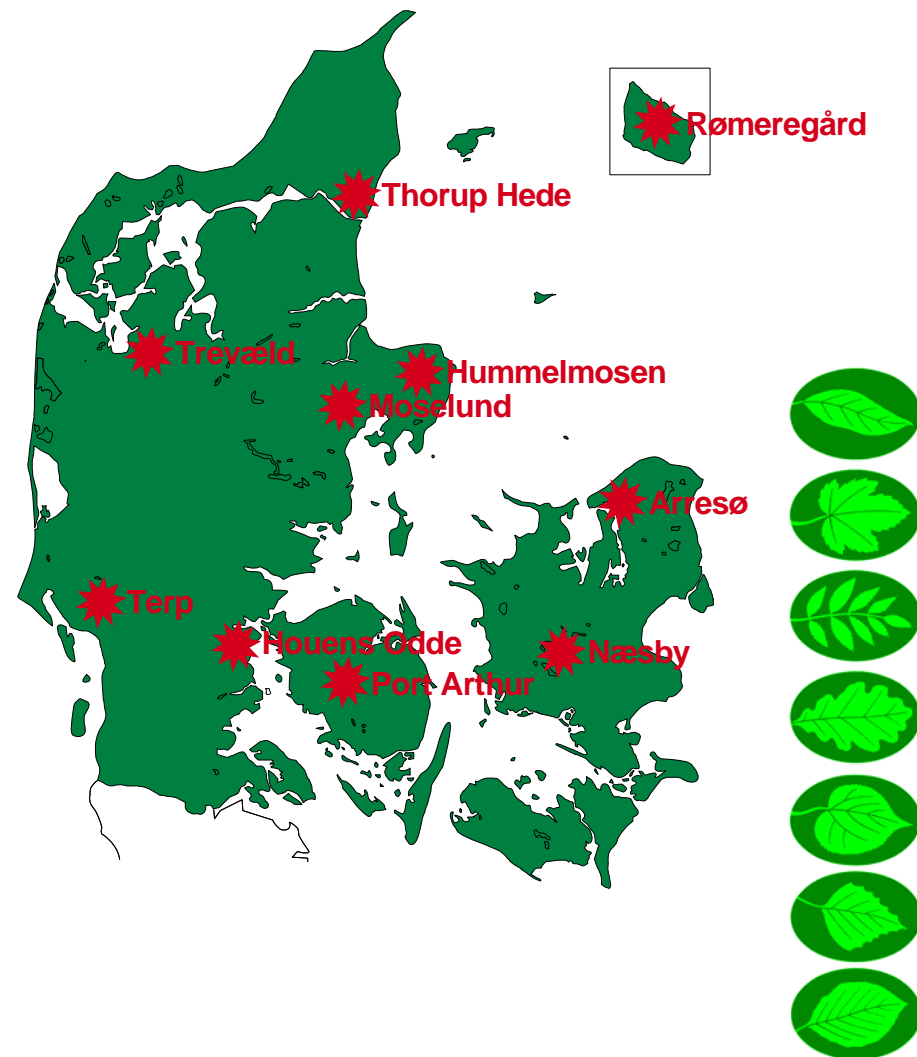

- ___ 6. Have joined an internet activity at the centre



- ___ 7. Have tried a least one activity special for the centre you have visited
- ___ 8. Have done nature activities at the centre
- ___ 9. Have participated in sorting the cabbage at the camp



- ___ 10. Have done environmental activities at the centre

The badge symbolise the Green Activity Centre and the activities you can experience:

- The green dot in the middle is of course a Green Activity Centre and working with nature
- The red triangle from within the KFUM-Scouts logo
- Brown is pioneering and woodcraft
- Yellow is the life in the camp and the trad. Danish yellow tents
- Blue is activities at lake and at sea
